### Bumps and bruises

We keep a book in which we record every accident, and we will inform you when you collect your child about any mishap which may have occurred. **WE ALWAYS NEED THREE EMERGENCY CONTACT NUMBERS (SWITCHED ON IF A MOBILE PHONE) IN CASE WE NEED TO CONTACT YOU.**

### Sickness

We understand that children can often cope well with colds and sniffs, but **if your child has been sick or has diarrhoea, please keep them at home for 48 hours after last episode.** Tummy bugs are extremely infectious and will spread quickly to children, families and staff. If your child becomes ill in nursery, we will phone you and ask you to collect him or her.

### Headlice

These little visitors do make appearances every now and then. Please don't panic – this is quite common in all schools and nurseries! We have advice sheets we can give you on how to treat them, and will issue these whenever we have a case of headlice.

### Toilet Training

Our priority is to make your child feel happy and independent in self help skills - to provide this children would benefit from accessing the toilets independently. Whilst we understand children may have occasional accidents we would appreciate your support in ensuring your child is toilet trained.
