Wider School Re-Opening.

Thursday 18th June 2020

Dear parents and Carers,

I am writing to you in response to the Mayor's social media activity and to try and provide some clarity. As I have communicated throughout, school will only re-open to specific year groups (identified by Liverpool City Council on The Department for Education's instruction) when it is safe to do so.

Key safety measures include the following.

1. Available space in classrooms around the school.
2. Available staffing.
3. Social distancing measures that are robust and uncompromised.
4. Availability of PPE equipment to deal with any suspected case of Coronavirus.

If safe to do so, we aim to try and bring back Year 6, Year 1, Reception and Nursery in some capacity before the end of term.

Currently we are open to vulnerable children and the children of keyworkers.

School will be re-opening to children in Year 6 from Monday 22nd June 2020. All parents have been called directly. Risk assessments have been drawn up to ensure we can offer an as safe as possible school environment for the children. I will write to the parents in year 6 before the weekend to explain the working day.

From Monday 22nd June we will be assessing our capacity to open to more children safely. When those assessments of risk and staffing capacity have been undertaken, we will let you know if we will be able to open to any further year groups. Again, safety is paramount when taking any decisions on this wider re-opening.

These are frustrating times for you. And also for us as schools because we want to bring children back. Every school however, is different. Available space and staffing mean that some schools will be able to bring back more children than others. Some schools may be able to have children in full time, others on a part time basis. So please remember that despite what any other school in the city is doing, we are doing our absolute best to bring back as many children as we can but safely and responsibly.

I hope this provides some explanation and clarity on the current situation. I am in constant contact with the Local Authority for guidance and support and they support us in our view that we must proceed carefully. I am keen to avoid mixed messages and so I wanted you to hear from me what our intentions at Corinthian are.
